

ORDINANCE NO. 04-02

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSING OF A SECTION OF THE MUNICIPAL STREET SYSTEM; REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, O.C.G.A. § 32-7-2(c) provides the procedures for the closing of sections of a municipal street system; and

**WHEREAS**, it is within the authority of the City Council of the City of Fort Gaines to close streets within the municipal street system of the City of Fort Gaines; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful study and deliberation, the City Council of the City of Fort Gaines has determined that a portion of Lafayette Street within the municipal street system has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has provided notice to the property owners on the subject street that the City may declare a portion of said Lafayette Street to be abandoned;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Fort Gaines as follows:

**Section 1.** That section of the municipal street system within the City of Fort Gaines being that portion of Lafayette Street which runs between North Bluff Street and Jackson Street and borders the property currently owned by Friday Night Properties, LLC and Porter Blaylock, more particularly described in "Exhibit A" hereto, has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial purpose is served by it, and it is hereby abandoned.

**Section 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
